CNSA Recommendations During Covid - 19

Dear Nursing Students of California,

Recently, Governor Newsom announced the inception of the California Health Corp. This is an opportunity for nursing students to potentially be placed in healthcare facilities to help care for non-COVID-19 patients in order to ease the burdens on these facilities. The BRN has approved these Health Corp hours to count towards clinical credit. However, to be clear, it is still a decision of the individual nursing schools as to whether or not they will indeed count these hours for academic credit and this will vary on a school by school basis. With this in mind, we recommend all students who are considering participating in Health Corp to reach out to their nursing department faculty for clarity regarding whether or not their specific school will be offering clinical credit. 


